**THANK YOU** for once again allowing Calvary Baptist Church to be a missional drop-off location for the OCC collection week! We couldn't do it without the use of the building and manpower when needed.

#### Numbers

SE Idaho and surrounding area – 5,270, a new record high! Northwest (5 state region) – 361,905, a new record high! United States – 10,051,570 International – 11,330,126

From Idaho Falls the trailer went to Denver, CO for the shoebox gifts to be processed, sorted and cartonized by gender and age. From Denver the boxes went to Mexico, a Hard-to-Reach Area, Native American Tribes in New Mexico, and Mali.

### North Carolina Report

Phil and Jeannette Hartung went to Charlotte, NC to team station leads in the processing center for two weeks December 4-16. We each had a station of volunteers we oversaw and guided as every box had to be checked for items that are not allowed to be in the boxes and to make sure they were full (we saw many that only had 1 or 2 items in them). We worked the evening shift, 3-10:30pm Monday-Saturday the first week and then Monday-Thursday the second week. Each day, both shifts processed over 100,000 boxes with a 4-week total of over 2 million Gospel Opportunity boxes! Thank you for your prayers as we traveled and served, as only God could give us the strength to do this ministry. We look forward to doing this again soon.

### **Packing Party News**

This year, beginning in May, we will be collecting items each month, until October, with a packing party on Saturday, November 2.
