

Why Praying for Our Missionaries is Important

Each month we've been focusing on learning about and praying for one of our SBC missionary families. In January our children's Sunday School classes viewed a video, learned about and prayed for the Argueta family. Melisa Argueta shared this update on how they have been encouraged by prayers and support:

"We were chosen as the missionaries of the month of January by 'Women on Mission' [National WMU] which means that many churches are praying for us, especially women and children. It has been an amazing experience. God has encouraged our hearts in a way I couldn't explain. We received many cards like the one you see in this photo, children of preschool or school age have written us words of encouragement that have arrived just at the time we needed them most. Only God knew the anxiety that was in my heart the day we received one of the groups of cards. When I opened the envelope and began to read each one, I began to cry but with joy, to see how God is a close, personal God, who knows our hearts and uses even such small children for His glory. As you can see, this was written by a boy or




girl of approximately 5-6 years old, but they were the right words I needed to hear that day. On many of the cards the same verse was repeated: 'Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.' 1 Peter 5:7. And the message on that card says: 'Argueta Family: just remember that God sent you for something, and you followed Him and His plan for you worked.'"

Youth Happenings

Our next big event for Student Ministry is DiscipleNow – a weekend of study, introspection and fun taking place March $15^{\rm th}$ through the $17^{\rm th}$.
